TIME OF PRAYER

HOMILY: Lawrence Exodus 14: 10- 14 & 30,31

When Pharaoh drew near, the people of Israel lifted up their eyes, and behold, the Egyptians were marching after them, and they feared greatly. And the people of Israel cried out to the LORD. 11 They said to Moses, "Is it because there are no graves in Egypt that you have taken us away to die in the wilderness? What have you done to us in bringing us out of Egypt? 12 Is not this what we said to you in Egypt: 'Leave us alone that we may serve the Egyptians'? For it would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the wilderness." 13 And Moses said to the people, g"Fear not,stand firm, and see the s alvation of the LORD, which he will work for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, yo u shall never see again. 14 iThe LORD will fight for you, and you have only to be silent." Thus the LORD saved Israel that day from the hand of the Egyptians, and Israels aw the Egyptians dead on the seashore. Israel saw the great power that the LORD used against the Egyptians, so the people feared the LORD, and they believed in the LORD and in his servant Moses.

We know the story of the Crossing of the Red Sea:

- The plagues
- The Passover
- Toward the Promised Land God turns them toward the desert and into the sea

The themes/messages of this story:

- The people are helpless, thankless and grumpy
- God will rescue them but will do so in a way that accomplishes more than simply removal:
 - o He will gain glory over the Egyptians
 - o The Egyptians will no longer have any authority over God's people completely free
 - o The Faith/belief of the people in God will increase

A good picture of the cross

- Our relationship with sin is one of enslavement. It is not a DYI project
- The work of the cross includes
 - o Our rescue from enslavement
 - Our freedom
 - o The crushing of our former master
 - o A work only God can accomplish

A good picture for Covid-19

- God is our rescuer and deliverer
- He has turned us, what appears to be into the desert, for his glory
- We should expect and look for places of God's intervention
- A time for faith to grow for eyes to be opened to who God is I am the LORD
