In early spring, residents of Luther Place approached the Acadia Network (schools, churches, social workers, businesses) for help with food needs. Transportation to and from the Calgary Food Bank is the main barrier for clients.

The Network agreed to assist and the "Acadia Food Pantry" was born. Housed in MacDougall United Church, the pantry offers fresh and non perishable foods on the third Tuesday of each month. (this Tuesday, August 20 from 12:00 noon - 1:00 pm) Volunteers are needed from 10:00 am - 1:30 pm and can contact Donna Gordon (dlgordon@shaw.ca) for more information.
