This would involve working closely as a small group and closely with the family, particularly for the first few months of their lives in Canada, helping them learn budgeting and financial survival in Canada.



Below are a few other areas of need at this time.

- Translators – do you know someone who speaks Arabic and could assist?
- Shopping Group (helping the family learn to about food shopping)
- Teaching new cooking skills to a young mother and father
- Employment Group (connecting with employment opportunities – the father has some cooking skills)
- Cultural Outings – getting to know and experience the city and area
- Phones and Technology Group
