## **SERMON NOTES**

- 1. Common threads: Luke 15
- a. Something of great value went missing: a sheep, a coin, and a son.
- b. The sheep, the coin, and the son were so valuable that being lost warranted an all-out search to find them.
- c. When they were found all-out parties ensued!
- 2. "In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents." (Lk. 15:10)
- 3. For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son (Jn. 3:16-18).
- 4. Condemned to what?

Ps. 49:12, 15; Job 24:21-24; Dan. 12:2; 2 Thess. 1:8-9; Mt. 23:33; Mt. 10:28; Mt. 18:8; Lk. 16:32; Mt. 8:12; 25:30; Mt. 25:46.

- 5. The good news of the gospel is this: that we are new creations, that we are reconciled to God, and that God does not count our sins against us (2 Cor. 5:18-21).
- 6. Q. How do we share the good news of the gospel as Christ's ambassadors? A. I think it begins with character.
