2017: The Starting Block

Sunday Jan. 8, 2017

- 1. New Year's Resolutions Soft Stats: half of us (on average) make New Year's resolutions half of those give up their resolutions within the first 6 months of the New Year only roughly 10% of this 25% are successful at keeping to their resolution to year's end.
- 2. New Year Recap:
 - God has a plan for our lives.
 - God has and will walk with us.
 - God knows us and loves us.
 - God invites us to participate with Him in the story He's telling of love and hope.
- 3. Strategies for successful resolution keeping:
 - Make one resolution, be specific and focus on it.
 - Attach a specific behavior to it. Make it measurable.
- 4. KISS: Keep It Short and Simple
- 5. SMART: Specific, Measurable, Agreed Upon, Realistic, Time-Based.
- 6. Strategies for successful resolution keeping:
 - Practice. Take the time to work on your resolution.
- 7. Keeping to our resolutions will be hard to do if we aren't convinced of WHY we do them.
- 8. What Spiritual New Year's resolutions might we make as we push out from the 2017 starting block?
- 9. Resolution Making Guidelines:
 - Be encouraged: you're not alone!
- 10. I can do everything through him (Jesus) who gives me strength (Phil. 4:13)... If a man remains in me (Jesus) and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing (Jn. 15:5).
- 11. Resolution Making Guidelines:
 - Ask God for the wisdom to make a God-worthy resolution AND for the wisdom on how to fulfill it.
