

 - "the Word of God" and phrases like it appear almost 4000 X within the pages of the bible
 - An average of 61 claims of divine authorship per book
 - It is "God-breathed" + Holy Spirit empowered
- 5. The bible is a book for our times.
- 6. The bible offers us emotional support (Jn. 16:33; Zeph. 3:17; Ro. 8:31, 38-39).
- 7. The bible gives us moral and spiritual direction.
