Disciplines of a Disciple

A Working Definition

- a) “A spiritual discipline is, when practiced faithfully and regularly, a habit or regular pattern in your life that repeatedly brings you back to God and opens you up to what God is saying to you.”
- b) “Spiritual disciplines, then, are spiritual exercises that one engages in habitually which bring one closer to God and thus become more godly in character and behavior”

Spiritual disciplines can be described as behaviors that facilitate spiritual growth.

Disciplines of a Disciple

H – have alone time with God.

A – accountability.

B – bible memorization.

I – be involved in your Faith Community.

T – tithe, give generously.

S – study your bible.

Disciplines of a Disciple

Accountability questions:

1. Have you been with a woman anywhere this past week that might be seen as compromising?
2. Have any of your financial dealings lacked integrity.
3. Have you exposed yourself to any sexually explicit material?
4. Have you spent adequate time in Bible study and prayer?
5. Have you given priority time to your family?
6. Have you fulfilled the mandates of your calling?
7. Have you just lied to me?
