 - Because testimony is telling about what we know to be true from our experience
 it is speaking the truth as far as we know it.
 - Because testimony instructs the church.
 - Because testimony strengthens people for the struggle it can prepare us for it and give us hope through it.
 - Because testimony brings healing through shared experience.
 - Because testimony helps us remember that God is in charge.
- 2. Two types of stories: salvation stories and growth stories.
- 3. At Crossroads Community Church we believe that...
 - baptism is a command of the Scriptures to be baptized and to baptize others (Mt. 28:19-20).
 - baptism is for those who believe in Jesus Christ (Ro. 6:3-7).
 - a person can be baptized at any time *after* they have committed their life to following Jesus Christ (Acts 2:41; 10:44-48).
 - baptism by immersion makes the most sense (Mk. 1:9-10; John 3:23; Acts 8:38-39).
