- 4. Select a Scripture passage as a group (maybe Gen. 1:3-5?). Do a micromeditation: PRAY. READ. THINK. APPLY.
- 5. Here are some of the commands of Jesus to his followers:
 - Follow me (Mt. 4:19)
 - Keep your word (Mt. 5:33-37)
 - Go the second mile (Mt. 5:38-42)
 - Love your enemies (Mt. 5:44)
 - Practice private spiritual disciplines (Mt. 6:1-18)
 - Honor your parents (Mt. 15:4)
 - Make and baptize and teach disciples (Mt. 28:19)

How might obeying these commands benefit you? How might ignoring them hurt you? What do you think Paul means by saying, "Everything is permissible but not everything is beneficial" (1 Cor. 10:23).
