The Religious Spirit

Read

"That's the thing about the Religious Spirit. It comes disguised as something good, it's a twisting of what God intended for our benefit. Mark Buchanan calls it, "corruption masquerading as goodness." He says, "the Religious Spirit is a dangerous spirit because it's evasive and camouflaged. It shape-shifts. It's seditious, insidious, always posing as its opposite: keeper of virtue, upholder of purity, protector of doctrine, defender of truth. It's rigidity masking as piety. It's control pretending to be watchfulness. It's judgment posing as discernment." The religious spirit is corruption masquerading as goodness; legalism passed off as righteousness; moralism dressed up as holiness; obligation disguised as obedience."
