We continue to pay close attention to the developments concerning COVID-19. We receive regular updates and information from the [Government of Canada](#), the [Provincial Health Officer](#), the [BC Centre for Disease Control](#), and [Fraser Health](#). We also receive direction from both our [C&MA District Office](#) and National Ministry Centre. We encourage you to stay informed with the latest information from the [BC Centre for Disease Control](#).

Our goal as a church community is to continue to be a welcoming place for all people to experience the light and life of Jesus. As such, we are taking steps to ensure the continued well-being of our church family and our local community:

- The most important thing we can do to prevent the spread of illness is to **wash our hands regularly and avoid touching our face**. Please remember to cough into a tissue and dispose of the tissue into the garbage, or sneeze into your elbow.
- We will **refrain from customary greetings such as handshakes, high-fives, and hugging**. Instead, we will welcome others with a wave, elbow bump, or smile!
- We will be receiving the **offering at the end of the service**. Ushers will hold the offering basket at the doors of the church when you exit so that you do not need to touch the basket. Remember you can also give online by visiting www.surreyalliancechurch.org.
- We will continue to **clean and disinfect the church**, paying special attention to objects and surfaces in high traffic areas and the children's ministry areas. We are also adding hand sanitizers throughout the building. (These are on backorder, but will be installed when they arrive.)
- **Extra seating** will be set up in the sanctuary to help provide the recommended 1-2 metre distancing for those that attend our services.
- **If you have a fever, respiratory symptoms, or believe you are ill**, we ask that you stay home and listen to the sermon series when it is posted online at the beginning of each week. Please keep us posted so that we can be praying with you and for you!
- Our next Communion is scheduled for our Good Friday service on April 10th. We will have more information regarding our time around the Lord's Table before then.

In this season where it would be easy to find ourselves gripped by fear, we will remember to be strong and courageous. God is still God and He is still in control. Let's trust Him while we do all we can to represent Jesus and to serve our community well during this season!

And remember – we believe in a big God, so we will pray big and pray often!
