April 28, 2019

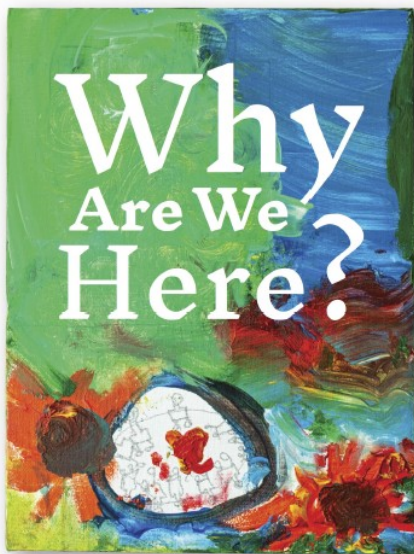

Mary Jo Leddy is a writer and theologian, the founder of Toronto's Romero House, a founding editor of *The Catholic New Times*, and a passionate advocate for human rights and peace issues. She is the recipient of many honorary doctorates, and awards, including the Order of Canada. She has written many books, several of which feature or reflect on the work and life at Romero House, such as *Radical Gratitude* (Orbis 2002), and *The Other Face of God: When the Stranger Calls Us Home* (Orbis 2011).
