Gift Card Fundraiser

St. David's is entering into a new Fundraiser Venture with Fundscrip. Fundscrip allows you to purchase gift cards directly through St. David's and have them conveniently delivered to the Church!

How does it work?

1. Grab an order form from the table in the front hall.
2. Fill in the order form to purchase gift cards for popular retailers at face value. Spend \$25 and get a \$25 gift card in return.
3. For each gift card sold, a portion of the proceeds (ranging from 2-10%) come directly to St. David's.

It's really that simple! We get paid for the shopping **that you already do!**

- Order forms are available now on the table in the front hall.
- Use your order form to purchase gift cards to give as Christmas gifts, to donate to our giving tree campaign, or to use for your normal monthly or holiday shopping
- Popular retailers include Real Canadian Superstore, Walmart, Dollarama, Safeway, Petro Canada, Starbucks, Tim Hortons, Staples, Toys R Us, Amazon and many more!
- Hand your completed order form and money into the Church office or at the table set up in the foyer on **Sunday December 1**.
- Your gift cards will arrive for pick up on or before December 15. Lots of time to use them for Holiday shopping or to donate them to the giving tree.

2020 Campaign

- Throughout 2020, we encourage you to get in the habit of ordering gift cards each month to use for your regular weekly shopping.
- You spend the same amount, but St. David's gets to earn money in the process.
- Order forms and money will be collected on **the first Sunday of each month** or can be turned into the Church Office at any time.
- Gift cards can be picked up on the Second Sunday of each month.
- Use your gift cards throughout the month for every day shopping, entertainment, and gifts.
