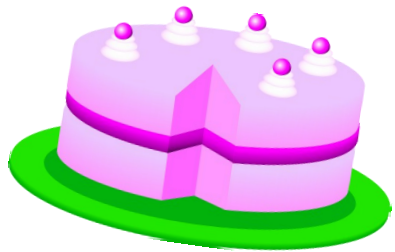
WHAT CAN YOU LEARN FROM A PIG, A MONKEY, AND A PEASANT GIRL?
