1:12-13

- The people respond in obedience!
- Their circumstances haven't changed, but they choose to move forward with God, rather than struggle against him

I AM with You

- Promise to Moses, Joshua, Judges, Kings, Prophets
- Promised in the New Testament: Jesus to disciples, his last words. To Paul, to the first Christians
- Haggai's listeners need this message at this time

1: 14-15

- God stirs the people up
- Deuteronomy picture of God stirring up his people like an eagle pushes chicks out of the nest

2: 1-5

- The people get overwhelmed with the magnitude of the situation
- Haggai recognizes their attitude, names it but reminds that God's with them
- The Temple wasn't going to be like it was, but this doesn't mean they stop working
- "Be strong", act, take courage
- The same mighty God who was with these people is with us
- "Don't be afraid" most common command in the Bible

What we can learn:

- We are not alone
- Don't have to be afraid
- Take decisive action in what God has assigned you
