	For the Win: Be Alert!
•	Generations past grew up with a naturalistic worldview that everything operates by natural laws and causes and the supernatural has no bearing on the world we live in.
•	In our culture today, a monster shift is taking place from a natural to a supernatural world view.
•	The Bible has always been painting a picture of a world that is both physical and spiritual (Eph 6:10-18)
•	Paul tells us to "be alert" of the spiritual battle waging around us.  O If we aren't alert, then we can't stand.
•	We need to be alert so that we can stand "when the day of evil comes".
	<ul> <li>"the day of evil" is that day when the spiritual battle is most sever and critical in your life.</li> <li>The enemy roams around looking for those who are</li> </ul>

- o The vulnerable and then strikes (Job 1:7, 1 Peter 5:8)
- o How do you respond when the day of evil comes?
- Jesus experienced a day of evil and he took his stand perfectly (Luke 4:1-13)
- We need to follow Jesus' example:

- Jesus fights by acknowledging the enemy
- o Jesus fights with scriptural truth
- Jesus fights through fasting
- As a church, we are going to be starting a 40-day fasting challenge, with a bible devotional, because fasting brings alertness to the spiritual realities around us since we are depriving ourselves of the physical.
