

## For the Win: Kingdoms at War

- When we claim allegiance to Jesus, we assure ourselves a share in his victory, but also place ourselves at odds with the kingdom of the enemy (Phil 3:20, Col 1:13)
- The entire story of the Bible and human history is that of two kingdoms at war.
  - Introduction: Garden paradise with one rule.
  - Rising Action: Satan fights against God, deceives humanity, and fights against God's people
  - Climax: Jesus claims victory through the cross and resurrection
  - Falling Action: Jesus commands his disciples to carry out the victory onto completion, and empowers them through giving them the Holy Spirit
  - Conclusion: Jesus fights the last battle and restores all things to the way they were originally intended
- We are currently in the "Falling Action" of the story. The victory is won but the battle still wages on.
  - Like in the days after D-Day but before total victory
  - The war is already won, but there are still battles to be fought because the enemy is not totally defeated
- If you are a follower of Jesus, there will be more battles but also more victory (Luke 9:1)
- We have the Holy Spirit who is much more powerful than the evil spirits that fight against (John 20:21-22, Luke 4:1-2)
- We need to acknowledge there is an enemy and actively fight against him
