## How to Heal Your Soul Identity

- We are all searching for our true-self because our true-self is who God created us to be. It is our true home.
- In the parable of the Prodigal Son, Jesus tells a story of homecoming (Luke 15), which is illustrative of our spiritual life journey.
- We all begin in a home that's insufficient in some way but gives us an inheritance to work with. Equipped with that, we set out to find ourselves and build an identity.
- We eventually come to the end of our resources and a true identity crisis.
  - In this moment there's an invitation to begin our journey back to the Father (Mat 18:1-4).
  - In the Father's arms we become like children again and find our true-selves in God's arms.
- Unlike the jealous and unhelpful older brother, Jesus is the perfect older brother who sets out to bring us back to the Father at great cost to himself.
  - The Holy Spirit is his homing device that draws us
- Tips for the road:
  - You need a deep level of self-awareness (write a biography of yourself in the 3<sup>rd</sup> person)
  - Name your false identity in a sentence. "I'm okay, as long as..."
  - Discover your true identity in God's eyes and put it into a sentence.
