Messy: Joining God in the Mess

“Born into the Mess”

- Whatever the messiness may be, we long for someone to relate to our hurts & struggles with understanding and not judgment.
- Jesus is the One who can relate to us, comfort us, heal us and forgive us. (John 3:16-17, Phil 2:3-8)
 - Although Jesus is God’s Son, He did NOT exploit His advantages but instead now joins us in the mess.
- Jesus was the purest and cleanest person to ever walk this earth, but He chose to live a messy life amid the messiest people of society.
 - Lepers were the truly messy & untouchable of society but Jesus reached out and touched them. (Luke 5:12-13)
- Jesus is not one to keep His hands clean and stay out of the mess. Rather, He is one who reaches out into mess.
 - Therefore, messiness is next to godliness.
 - God wants to walk with you in the messiness of life.
 - We need to follow Jesus’ example to help the messy (Phil 2:3-8)
- My challenge to you this week is to find someone or some situation that you might consider lower than you and step into the mess to serve and to help.
