
Sermon Summary: Jan 26, 2020

BETTER-TOGETHER: Fellowship

Acts 2:42-47

- We all have a deep need for relationship & community yet we often disregard this.
 - o Our culture is very individualistic.
 - Extreme individualism bothers us because we were made for community (Gen 2:18).
- The has a special word for community between disciples of Jesus:
 Fellowship
 - The word fellowship comes from the Greek word "Koinonia" which implies a much deeper relationship than we experience in our culture.
- The church is called to have true fellowship like that exemplified in the early church (Acts 2:42-47).
 - The early church ate together with glad and sincere hearts.
 - $\circ\quad$ The early church shared with those who were in need.
- True fellowship has been exemplified in Jesus.
 - His sacrifice enables us to eat with God at his banquet table.
 - His sacrifice enables us to share in his inheritance so we could be called sons and daughters of God.
