Sermon Summary, Sept 22, 2019

Serving All Hands on Deck

- Jesus has given us a divine mission to accomplish: The Great Commission (Mat 28:18-20).
- Jesus commissioned his disciple once before (Mat 9:35-38).
 - We can learn a lot about how to carry out the mission from this text.
- There was a sense of urgency about accomplishing God's mission (9:36).
 - Jesus was moved by compassion for the people that needed help.
 - It is our compassion for who are hurting and in need that gives us urgency for doing God's mission.
- There is a sense of opportunity about accomplishing God's mission (9:37-38).
 - The problem is not the lack of potential but the lack of workers.
 - To better accomplish God's mission we need to have all hands on deck.
- The "chain link principle:" Each time someone serves it is a link in the chain of someone being discipled.
- Let's pray and ask the Lord of the harvest to raise up workers!
