“Faith & Science: Conflicting or Complementary?”

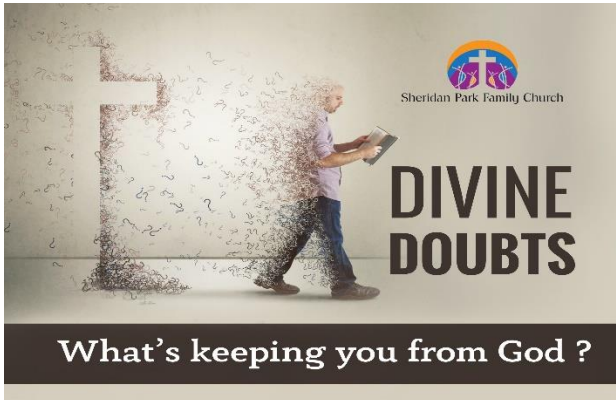
For many Christians, university is a difficult place to hold on to belief, let alone practice it openly. The 1st year on campus is often quite a challenge. Dr. Luke Janssen (Professor of Medicine, McMaster University) held a “strong” Christian faith for decades while pursuing a career in medical sciences, but found his entire belief system eroded by his experience on campus. He eventually had to give up the faith he grew up with. However, after years of pursuing the questions and frictions generated between those two major influences in his life, he rediscovered a Christian faith that is entirely compatible with modern science. In fact, it was actually science itself that helped him get to that point. The Faith-versus-Science Debate had become a Faith-and-Science Dialogue, and he wants to share that experience and strategies with students on the University of Waterloo campus. Divine Doubts

Is Faith Anti-Science?

- There is nothing wrong with having doubts so long as we push through our doubts towards reasonable conclusions.
- One of the most common doubts that people have is that faith in God is anti-science.
- There is actually no contradiction between science and religion, but it is something that has been fabricated.
 - The media paints a science vs religion war.
 - It's a historical misconception that the church opposed scientific discovery.
- Christianity has always promoted science.
 - Christianity laid down the philosophical framework for the birth of modern science.
 - The Bible promotes scientific observation (Rom 1:19-20)
- The “myth of secular society” has been busted.
 - Humanity has not become more secular as it becomes more scientific.
- Science and religion are usually seen as clashing over the topic of evolution.
 - There are many views of creation that harmonize the Bible and science well.
- Science should draw us towards God but it can also be used as an excuse to avoid God and worship things we want.
- We have to be honest with ourselves and with others about our divine doubts and seek to help and be helped.
