Sermon Summary: July 29, 2018

Connect – Privacy or Intimacy

- Intimacy is foundational to deep and meaningful relationship.
 - We all long for intimacy in our lives because we were created in the image of an intimate God.
- Yet we covet our privacy.
 - Our level of intimacy is subordinate to our level of privacy. The more privacy you have the less intimacy you will have.
 - We keep things private because they are rotten and we are afraid of how God and others might reject us if we bring it before them (John 3:16-21).
- The truth about our God is that he sent his one and only Son to save us and not to condemn us.
 - If you truly believe that God laid Himself bare on the cross for you then you will not hesitate to lay your life bare at the foot of the cross.
 - When you do this, your darkness is transformed into light and you are set free.
- When we shed our privacy we are finally able to have intimate relationships like we desire, both with God and others. (1 John 1:5-7).
- "In what ways have you been too private in your life? How might you be able to open up to create more intimacy with others?"
