Connect – Friendship

- God is relationship and He created humanity in His image, therefore we are made for relationship.
- But friendship is a relationship that is lacking today more than anything.
 - The mobility of our culture hurts friendship.
 - Friendship, in our culture, is overshadowed by romantic relationships
 - It has also been overshadowed by vendor friendship.
- True friendship is irrational because it is not dependent on getting something in return.
- True friendship is a choice.
 - It is the least instinctive, natural, or necessary of relationships.
- God is the ultimate friend.
 - God freely and irrationally chooses to love us unconditionally.
 - It is possible for everyone to have a friendship with God.
