# Sermon Summary:

## **Connect - S.A.F.E. Neighbours**

- We were created for relationship and community but we live in a world of isolation.
- The New Testament church was radically connected in relationship.
- There are four factors that promote deep and meaningful relationships that were present in the New Testament church.
  - **Spontaneity:** Relationships cannot be planned because they involve people who are dynamic and unpredictable, just like life.
  - **Accessibility:** If you're not accessible then people can't get in and they won't want to get in.
  - **Frequency:** When people connect frequently a relationship is strengthened, it's that simple.
  - **Eating together:** There is just something about how we are made that allows us to connect over food.
- These four factors are all interconnected.
- When you have these factors together then deep and meaningful relationship is sure to happen.
- Just like the New Testament church, relationship and community is where God's mission is accomplished.
- The place where SAFE relationships can most naturally occur is in our neighbourhood.
