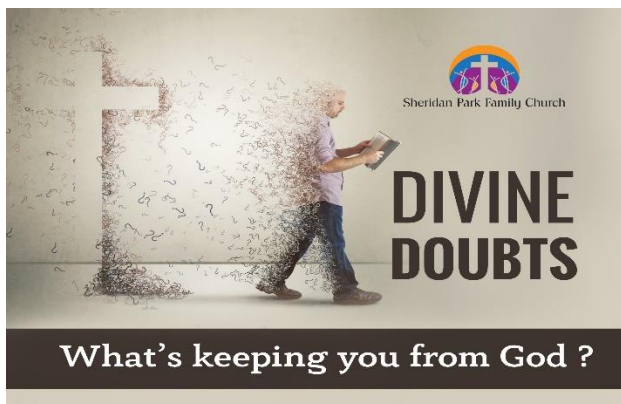

Small Group Discussion Questions: Sept 30, 2018

Does God Exist?

1. If this is the first time your small group is meeting, have everyone share a little about themselves.
2. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling? Explain.
3. Do you know anyone personally that doesn't believe God exists? Why do they believe what they believe?
4. Have you ever struggled with doubting the existence of God? What made you doubt?
5. The speaker presented the "fine tuning" argument for the existence of God. Do you find this argument compelling? Why or why not?
6. How does the fine-tuning argument for the existence of God impact the "conflict" between science and Christianity?
7. What are other arguments for the existence and non-existence of God?
8. Personally, what is the strongest reason you believe in the existence or non-existence of God?
9. In your group, choose two people to take opposite stances on the question "Does God Exist?" Have them engage in a charitable and fair conversation about it (5 min). Then have the group provide feedback on what was said.
