Sermon Summary: April 21, 2019

Luke 24:36-53 – Resurrection Response

- The implications of the resurrection are earth-shattering, because to accept that Jesus rose from the dead is to accept the truth of who he was, what the Bible says about him and of why he died.
 - o Therefore, it demands a response from everyone.
- Responses to Jesus' resurrection:
 - Startled and frightened.
 - Troubled and doubting.
- Jesus responds to our doubt today as he did to the disciples, by giving us proof.
 - The disciples could not have fabricated the resurrection because they didn't think it was possible.
 - Jesus' followers did not venerate his tomb because they had the real thing.
- One way in which we respond to being presented with the proof of the resurrection is to disbelieve because the implications of the resurrection being true are just far too scary for people most to handle
- Do you discard the magnificent truth of the resurrection to maintain your confirmation bias towards the life you have built? Or do you accept the beautiful resurrection and rebuild your life around that?
- Most importantly His sacrifice on the cross.
