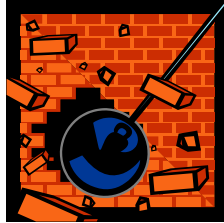

The Larger Christian Life:
Removing Obstacles

- The church is like a “Big Red Tractor” that the people push and pull instead of following the manual and using it like it was intended.
 - The manual and our experience do not fit.
- In order to obtain the larger Christian life it requires both human and heavenly intervention.
- God’s part is that he graciously gifts us with his Holy Spirit according to His grace.
 - The Spirit works in us to transform our lives only by His power.
- Our part is merely to allow the Spirit to work and not to quench the Spirit (1 Thes 5:19).
 - We may quench the Spirit by relying too heavily on our own efforts.
 - We may quench the Spirit by being too comfortable.
 - We may quench the Spirit because we are afraid of being disappointed.
 - We may quench the Spirit because we want the larger Christian life for my own benefit and not for God’s glory.
- We must identify the ways we personally quench the Spirit and seek to remove them before we can be Spirit-filled.
