Failure to Trust

Judges 6:16-40

- God strengthened Gideon's faith many times by showing him signs and miracles.
 - God audibly spoke to him, sent his angel to perform a miracle, protected him from certain death by the hands of the towns people, empowered him with His very Spirit, fulfilled His promise to have the people follow him, and performed two more miracles at Gideon's request.
- God worked patiently with Gideon to build his faith and to give him every advantage to trust in Him but Gideon's faith failed again and again.
- Despite God's faithfulness in our lives and our witness of miracles, we can never fully trust God.
- Jesus fully trusted in God on our behalf because we could not.
 - Because Jesus did this we are enabled to now trust in God.
 - Because Jesus did this we are motivated out of gratitude and worship to trust in a God who has bled for us.
