Sermon Summary: January 06, 2019

John 4:1-19 The Great Pursuer

- You can tell a lot about a person from the questions they ask.
- Jesus asked the woman at the well the most astonishing and significant question: “Will you give Me a drink?”
- Why was Jesus’ question so significant?
 - He had to travel through Samaria.
 - The Jews and the Samaritans hated each other.
 - He was alone on the wrong side of tracks.
 - He was a respected religious leader and God incarnate.
 - She was unclean.
 - She was a woman.
 - She was a home-wrecker.
- Jesus crossed all social and religious barriers to reach out to who society considered the lowest of people; God is the great pursuer.
 - His pursuit is astonishing because we don’t deserve it.
 - If we accept His pursuit, He will grant us living water that satisfies our hearts and leads us to eternal life.
 - It doesn’t matter how far we are from Jesus, we can always respond to His pursuit.
