- 1. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling? Explain.
- 2. Discuss last week's weekly challenge, "Find one part of the Bible with which you disagree". Ask yourself, 'If this is the Word of God to me, what needs to happen?"
- 3. What are some common historical "stains" on Christianity that you have heard mentioned by other people?
- 4. What are some experiences you've had, or observances you have made, had that might cause you to think religion is dangerous? How have you made sense of those experiences?
- 5. Pastor Keith said that history has taught that the human capacity for evil and oppression cannot be pinned on religion. How has your understanding changed in view of that teaching?
- 6. If any worldview can be high jacked to support one's agenda, can you think of an example?
- 7. Why might a non-religious worldview be dangerous?
- 8. The example of the abolition of slavery was used to show how true Christianity can suppress sinful tendencies. How do you understand this example? Can you think of other examples?
- 9. What are some present day reasons people believe religion to be dangerous? How would one deal with these ideas?
- 10. How can Jesus help you to be more loving?
- 11. Choose 2 people to debate "Is Religion Dangerous?" (5 min). Provide group feedback on the discussion.

Sermon Summary

<u>Divine Doubts</u> Is Religion Dangerous?

- There is a popular sentiment in Canada today that religion is dangerous because it's been the cause of so much war and oppression.
- The church has a stained past when it comes to wars and oppression, but so do all worldviews.
 - o Communist China & Russia, Nazi Germany, etc.
- Clearly religion is not to blame for the division, oppression, and hatred that is in this world. There is something in us as humans that has a great capacity for evil (Rom 7:21-24).
- Christianity at its core is the very least dangerous of all the worldviews out there.
 - A Secular "survival of the fittest" worldview is much more dangerous and oppressive.
- Since all humans have a propensity towards evil, a religious worldview helps to suppress that sin-nature.
 - Look at the example of the abolition of slavery by Christians.
 - Although slavery took place in Christian nations, as in all nations, it was the Christians that first came to the conclusion that it was wrong and should be stopped.
- True Christian religion teaches us to sacrifice ourselves for the benefit of those who are less fortunate not to use our power to exploit them.
 - Jesus showed us the example in the feeding of 5000 (John 6:1-15)
