

Who Needs God? Morality

Judges 19-21



1. What insight, principle or observation from this week's message did you find to be most helpful, eye opening or troubling? Please explain.
2. "Do what's right in your own eyes." Discuss how society might look if we really lived this out. In what ways are we already living this out today?
3. Can something be both morally right and wrong at the same time? Does morality change or evolve over time? Is morality objective (unchanging, a steady standard regardless of who adheres to it)? Explain.
4. Read Judges 19-21, or recount/retell the details of the story together as a group.
5. What about the story is most bizarre or unbelievable to you?
6. The Israelites did what was right in their own eyes and the destination wasn't pretty. Share how you have experienced or have seen this be true in your own life or others' (something seemed right at the time and proved to be very wrong in hindsight).
7. Every belief has outcomes or consequences if lived out. In your opinion, what are some consequences of following God's ways that keep us from following His way? Could this drive us to do what is right in our own eyes?
8. God's grace is greater than our sin. God was gracious to Israel even though they had done what was right in their own eyes. How might you fall on God's grace in this area as well and begin to do what is right in His eyes?
