What was at stake with the scrolls?

4. What does it teach us about Jesus that He alone was able to open the scrolls?

5. What titles were used to describe Jesus in this passage?

How do these titles point to God’s faithfulness to His promises throughout history?

READ JOHN 1:29-34. How did the picture of Jesus as the Lamb who was slain fulfill John the Baptist’s words in these verses?

6. During a time of global fear, which of God’s promises might you cling to now?

READ REVELATION 5:11-14

7. How do these verses describe those who observed the Lamb?

8. What drew such worship from them?

How should we respond likewise?

9. How might Jesus’ greatness be a comfort in the current upheaval and chaos we are facing in the world?
