Spring cleaning – inside and out







Inside:

Repair entrance floors damaged from salt and moisture.
Repair all leaks in walls, floors, windows and doors.
Book an annual inspection of the air conditioner.
Check water heaters for rust or wet spots on the floor.
Test main water shutoff valve to ensure it is operational.
Replace appliance water supply hoses routinely.
Maintain sump pumps.
Store materials off the floor, on pallets or shelving.
Consider installing a moisture detection system.







Spring cleaning – inside and out







Outside:

Clean eave troughs and drainpipes of all debris.
Check drainage paths to ensure storm water flows away
from the building.
Extend downspouts at least six feet from building.
Check outside water taps for freezing damage.
Trim trees to prevent damage from falling branches and to improve visibility of the property.
Replace damaged roof shingles.
Inspect the lightning protection system and arrange repairs of all breaks in the cables or lines.
Store tools and machinery in a secure location.
Forbid any "controlled" burning of grass, yard waste or
trash.
