PLEASE NOTE

As a result of our recent fire inspection and due to fire regulations, the following doors in the building must be kept closed at all times and not be left propped open for any reason. These are fire safe doors that are meant to keep a fire from spreading quickly into various rooms/areas and when necessary allow time for the safe exit of anyone in those rooms.

*The doors at the top and bottom of the basement stairs off of the back hallway.

*The 3 red doors at the top of the back stairs: the Recovery Room, the one leading to the 3rd floor apartment and the one leading to the 2nd floor common area.
