BY THE SPIRIT

50 years ago, J.I. Packer, a wise Christian theologian, stated in his book *Knowing God*, "The average Christian is in a complete fog as to what work the Holy Spirit does."

Although the ministry of the Spirit is widely sought and celebrated in some parts these days, Packer's conclusion is often still too true. This is startling in the light of the simple reality that the Christian life – life in Jesus – is, fundamentally, a life lived by the Spirit.

With this in mind, we are spending this season exploring together the person, passion and ministry of the Holy Spirit, not just for the sake of being informed, but so that we might truly honour, cooperate with and live by the Spirit.

This morning we will be considering together the vital question of how we hear and discern God's Voice in the age of the Spirit.

PRAYER MATTERS

We continue to remember our partnership with Food for the Hungry Project in the Sasiga Mid Highlands of Ethiopia. The project aims to end poverty for the area's 25,371 people, and currently directly supports the schooling of over 1,000 children. It works to improve the quality of education, better nutrition and disease prevention, increase economic opportunities for families, and equip community leaders.

We **give thanks** for the successful construction of five water points at springs in the communities which provide clean water access for 113 households - approximately 565 people. We **continue to pray** for the people of the Sasiga Mid Highlands, the staff working with them and for increased political stability in the area.

Additionally, we pray for over 35 of our members serving at Camp Imadene this week and the campers and volunteers they will be supporting.
