The project aims to end poverty for the area's 25,371 people, and currently directly supports the schooling of over 1,000 children. It works to improve the quality of education, better nutrition and disease prevention, increase economic opportunities for families, and equip community leaders.

Wegive thanks for the successful construction of five water points at springs in the communities which provide clean water access for 113 households - approximately 565 people. We continue topray for the people of the Sasiga Mid Highlands, the staff working with them and for increased political stability in the area.

Additionally, we pray for over 35 of our members serving at Camp Imadene this week and the campers and volunteers they will be supporting.
