FOLLOWME

Matthew 4:1

"A Christian, quite simply, is a *disciple* of Jesus, which is another way of saying that a Christian is one who follows Jesus Christ. This culminates in Matthew 28, where Jesus' mandate to his followers is to make disciples... Thus if someone were to ask, 'How do I become a Christian?' the answer would be, 'Become a disciple or follower of Jesus.'" (Gordon Smith, <u>Beginning</u> Well).

Today is our final Sunday exploring this call - what it means and why it matters. As we've come to see over these weeks - a disciple is someone who, by grace and by choice, is with Jesus to learn from Jesus to live like Jesus. This morning we come to the reinstatement of Peter after his denial of Jesus (John 21). Though years have passed since Jesus' first call to him on the shore of the Sea of Galilee, the call continues... As it does for us...
