If you'd prefer to keep your little one with you and need a quiet place there is a daycare room in the office lounge.

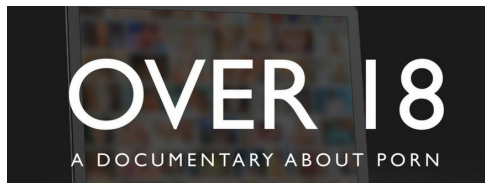
PRAYER MATTERS
