Matthew 4:19

"A Christian, quite simply, is a *disciple* of Jesus, which is another way of saying that a Christian is one who follows Jesus Christ. This culminates in Matthew 28, where Jesus' mandate to his followers is to make disciples... Thus if someone were to ask, 'How do I become a Christian?' the answer would be, 'Become a disciple or follower of Jesus.'" (Gordon Smith, Beginning Well).

As we've come to see over the last few weeks: a disciple is someone who, by grace and by choice, is with Jesus to learn from Jesus to live like Jesus. ## PRAYER MATTERS

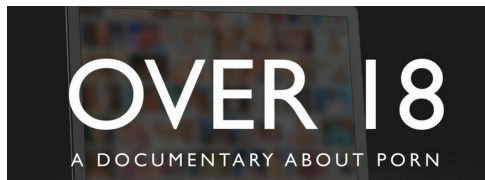
Today we pray for **Gateway Baptist church**, and our partners **International Justice Missions (IJM)** who work locally with governments, justice systems and communities to prevent abuse, and internationally to rescue the abused. We are thankful for their success in 2016 with over 1000 people rescued from slavery and violence. We are especially thankful for the 16 year old Kolkata girl rescued on the first night she would have been abused; that social workers and an emergency shelter were there for her. We are thankful that five suspects associated with the brothel were arrested. We pray for immense change in the societies in which even immediate family members feel they need to sell their girls into the sex trade.
