A second short term group is coming to do a daytime English Club for kids and an evening conversational English class for adults. Jenn has also been hosting two summer interns considering full time missions.

Please pray for plans to plant another church in the downtown core, for the timely completion of the new Florece building, and that the contacts made by the short-term teams will bear fruit. Please pray for Jenn too, as her Spanish continues to improve, and she prepares to start counselling clients of her own next month.
