After the Meal

The Great Commission

- John 13:33-35- Jesus gives *purpose* to his followers.
- John 14:12-15 & Acts 1:8- Jesus *empowers* those he sends with the Holy Spirit.
- This call must be embraced locally and globally—while it is still a personal call for every believer.

Generosity

- Matthew 14:13-21- The disciples notice only their limitations and desire to send away the crowds. Jesus supernaturally provides over and above what is necessary.
- We are a people blessed so that we can be a blessing to others—all to God's glory.
- Openhandedness is a direct reflection of our belief in the generosity of God.

Recognizing and Releasing

• Romans 12:6 & 1 Corinthians 12:7- God, by the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, freely gives gifts to all believers.

- We need a healthy community as a platform for recognizing gifts in ourselves and others.
- Church is not just for gathering, it is a place of equipping and sending out.

Bottom line: *Love like Jesus!*
