The Calgary Alliance for the Common Good will be holding its first public action assembly. We hold these assemblies to gather our members so that we can act together to bring about a significant change in our city.

At the October assembly we will have provincial and municipal officials present. We will be asking them to support our request to connect seniors to the non-medical homes supports they needs so that they can stay in their homes and connected to their communities.

We will also be gathering to listen to Chief Crowchild and other indigenous leaders to hear what work needs to be done to make reconciliation between indigenous and non-indigenous people a reality in our city.

Your presence is important. Not only is it a chance to experience the potential of our alliance, but by coming together, we are able to demonstrate our shared strength. This will put us in a place to establish a strong public relationship with our public officials and to have them respond by addressing the real need in our community to support seniors and to work towards reconciliation.
